II. Old Business:

- A. Centennial
 - 1. We have a few people who are making their final payments.
- B. Inspired by the Spirit

- C. Diocesan Annual Appeal
 - 1. Father provided updated numbers and shared that we have received \$10,000 in matching funds. If we receive all \$10,000 in gifts and the match, we will meet the goal and exceed it.
